#### Description

They are also weather and UV resistant (which strongly helps them maintain their colour). These properties are preserved within a broad temperature range from -40 to + 110 °C. The standard colours of the pavements are black, red and green. well as on concrete or bitumen surfaces. The paving elements may be joined by the attached plastic pins (16 pieces/m2 come with the supply, thickness of pavement from 30 mm). The paving elements may be cut to the required size in the course of their laying.
